We bring you warm greetings from our team here in San Diego, the doctors and nurses at our hospital, and especially the children of Mbarara, Uganda, whose lives you've changed so dramatically through your compassion and generosity.

The enclosed newsletter has the latest updates from the hospital. The big news is that we broke ground on our new surgical center in October! We expect the surgical center to be completed in late 2016. It will make Holy Innocents *the first complete pediatric care facility in Uganda*.

The "small news" is equally important – that's why we've included a story about infant Lael Love and her family, and an article by board member Scott Schafer linking an event 50 years ago to the surgical center today. These articles drive home how saving a child's life blesses a family in the near term, and impacts the future for generations to come....

We have always been an all-volunteer organization – no salaries, no rent, no expensive marketing. We are proud that since we began in 2007, 98 cents of every dollar donated have gone directly to the hospital and to the children of Mbarara. To accomplish this, we've partnered with universities, Rotary International, medical equipment providers and many others. We're sending our 13th medical & training mission to Mbarara in January 2016, led by board member Anita Hunter. Our goal has been, and remains, doing all we can to improve the health and lives of the children in Mbarara.

We have raised nearly one million dollars for building the surgical center. This covers approximately 90% of the construction cost. You can play a critical role in funding the remaining 10%. If you are able to include us in your end-of-year giving and send back the enclosed envelope, we would be so grateful!




